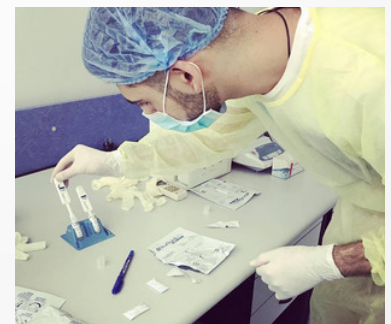
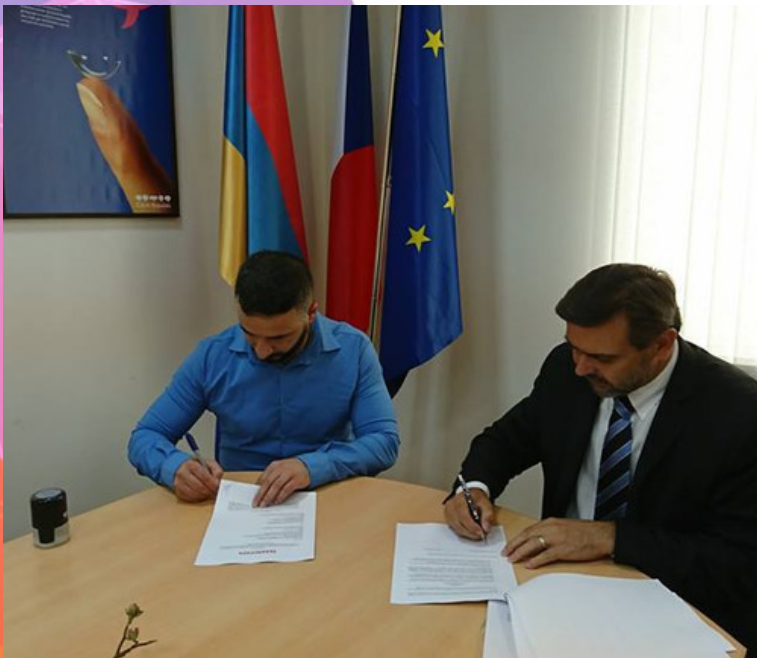

During the meeting the NNGO staff members developed new vision, mission, strategic directions and goals, as well as the operational plan of the Organization, reviewed its values, as well as made the PESTLE and SWOT analyses.

After these enthusiastic discussions, A. Galphayan conducted the meditation. Afterwards the participants shared their impressions. Everybody was very pleased with the whole event.

## "QUEER GATHERING" NEW SMALL INITIATIVE SUPPORT GRANT TO "RAINBOW ARMENIA" GROUP

On August 10, 2017 a small initiative support grant agreement was signed between the president of "New Generation" Humanitarian NGO Sergey Gabrielyan and representative of the "Rainbow Armenia" group Hayk Hakobyan.



According to the approved project "Queer gathering" the goal of the latter is to empower LGBTQI+ activists and to make them feel appreciated for their efforts that they are putting into their work. The gathering would also teach some people about village life and how we can be closer with nature and be in harmony with them.

The project is a 2-days gathering event in one of the villages of Armenia where the LGBTQI+ activists discussed "Activism", "Queer policies", "How to support those LGBTQI+ activists who live in provinces of Armenia" and other interesting topics.

## MONITORING VISIT FROM THE EMBASSY OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC IN ARMENIA

On August 4, 2017, Deputy Head of Mission, First Secretary of the Embassy of the Czech Republic in Armenia, Ani Saginjanova and Trade and Economic Section officer of the Embassy Davit Dilanyan made a monitoring visit to New Generation Humanitarian NGO (NGNGO) office. The aim of the visit was the discussion of activities and procedure of the CSOs and Mass Media in the Front Line for Elimination of Discrimination against LGBTI People in Armenia Project implemented by New Generation Humanitarian NGO with the financial support of Transition Promotion Program, Embassy of Czech Republic in Armenia. During the discussion the representatives of the Embassy addressed



their questions to the NGNGO staff on the project implementation stages, procedures and activities. NGNGO staff introduced to the Embassy representatives all the project activities implemented and that are to be implemented within the framework of the project, as well as all the strategic documents the NGO is guided by during the implementation of the project.

# LIFE2017 EDUCATIONAL PLATFORM FOR LGBTQI+ ACTIVISTS AND ALLIES IS LAUNCHED



On August 7, 2017 New Generation Humanitarian launched 3-day LIFE – Leadership, Information, Freedom, Equality, Information Platform. The participants arrived in the event venue with great enthusiasm and expectations to gain new knowledge and skills, and have an interesting and useful time. LIFE Information Platform is aimed at the empowerment and capacity building of LGBTIQ+ community, awareness-raising of beginner activists, developing activists' public speaking skills and effectively bringing the community problems to the frontline.



Topics to be presented during the platform are:

- Human Rights and Dignity
- Conflict Resolution
- Freedom of Speech, Public Speaking Skills
- Sexuality

LIFE 3-day information platform is held within the framework of Human Rights for Diversity and Equality project implemented with the financial support of the Norwegian Helsinki Committee.

## Seminar on Legal Literacy and The Basics of Activism

On August 21, 2017 launched a three-day seminar on "Legal Literacy and The Basics of Activism," which is implemented within the framework of "Right to Health" project. During the training, the participants from Armenia, Belarus, Georgia, Kyrgyzstan and Macedonia will get acquainted with the international and national mechanisms for the promotion of health care and fight against discrimination, they will also get practical

knowledge on work with mass media and on implementation of advocacy campaigns. The project is implemented by "New Generation" Humanitarian NGO with the financial support of Eurasian Coalition on Male Health (ECOM), on the funds of Global Fund to Fight Aids, Tuberculosis and Malaria.



## WE ARE LAUNCHING NGO BASED SALIVA TEST FOR HIV

We are glad to inform that for the first time in Armenia "New Generation" Humanitarian NGO is launching NGO based saliva testing for HIV (Implementation of oral mucosa transudate testing on HIV) among its beneficiary groups which will be provided in the office of the organization with the support of the prequalified experts for voluntary testing and consulting .

With this regard since August 2, 2017 the staff of the organization is attending requalification courses for saliva testing at the Republican Center for AIDS Prevention of Armenia. In frames of the courses the attendees make practical work to gain the relevant skills in order to use them after.
